**Definitions**

**Licensed Provider**

An individual whose name is listed as the license holder on the family child care license.

**Co-applicant**

A second caregiver and licensed provider.

**Second Adult Caregiver**

An adult caregiver who is not listed as a licensed provider.

**Occasional Emergency Substitute**

An adult who assumes the responsibility of the provider, but who is not listed as a licensed provider and works less than 30 hours in a 12 month period.

**Regular Substitute Caregiver**

An adult who assumes the responsibility of the provider, but who is not listed as a licensed provider and works more than 30 hours in a 12 month period, but not more than 30 days.

**Teenage Helper**

Individuals who are between 13 and 18 years of age who assist with care. They cannot be left alone with the children.
